- **Art: Drawing & Painting**

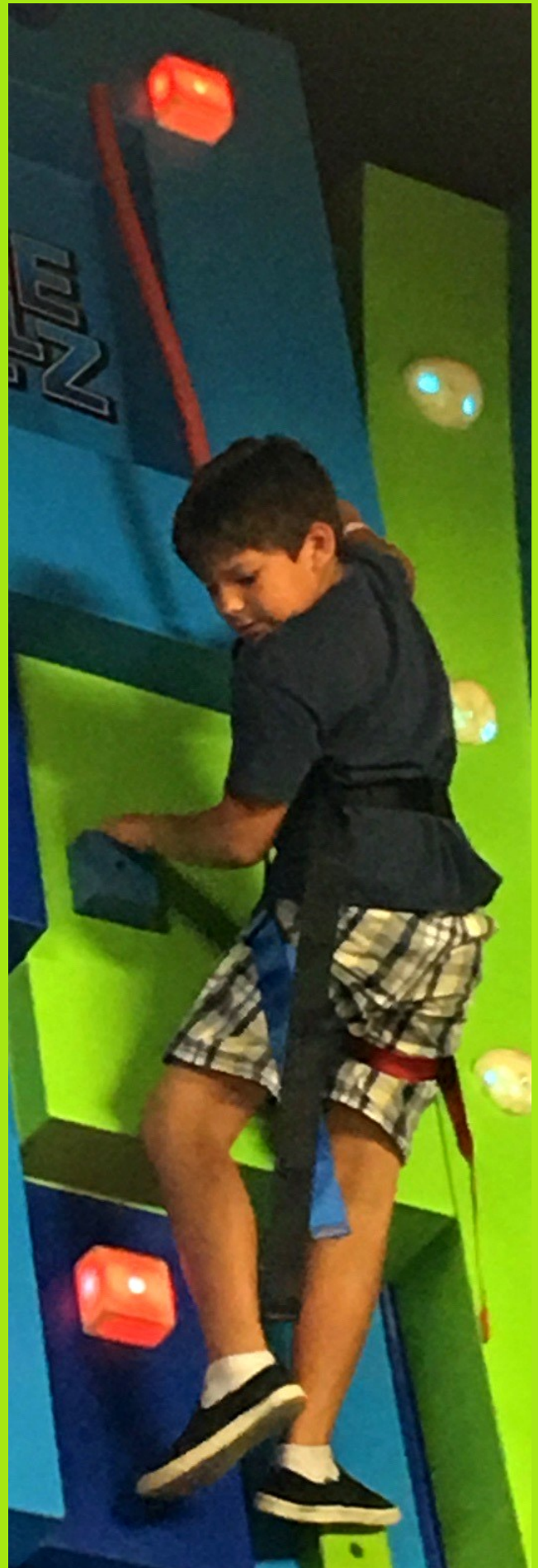
Campers will learn techniques to improve their drawing skills and paint beautiful masterpieces.

It is not anticipated, however, camp themes, specials, and field trips are subject to change.

**Expectations**– Campers are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that honors the Lord. We will be encouraging campers to talk, listen, apologize, and forgive. When necessary, time out may be used as well as loss of other privileges. If an issue arises that requires a more serious disciplinary response such as hitting or biting, parents will be contacted to come pick up their camper for the remainder of the day.

**Dress Code**– Campers will need to wear athletic shoes for various high-energy activities. Sandals are acceptable other times of the day. We ask that girls wear a one-piece swimsuit. If a two piece is worn, a t-shirt must be worn over it. Camp t-shirts are for field trip days.

**Health**– In the event that your child becomes ill, you will be notified promptly to pick up your child. If your child is recovering from an illness, he/she must be fever-free or diarrhea-free for 24 hours without the use of either fever reducing medications or anti-diarrheal medications before returning to camp.
