ESL (English as a Second Language) Levels and Annual Pricing

Advanced ESL

Advanced ESL is a limited ESL curriculum designed to support students with TOEFL Jr scores from 750—810. These students will attend regular ELA classes and study ESL during their foreign language classes. Advanced ESL students are more proficient in written and spoken English and will receive approximately 70 hours of ESL per year or about 2 hours per week. Students will also receive additional support from their classroom teachers.

Pricing

The additional cost for the Advanced ESL program is **\$1,854 per year** paid in full at the time of admission. Due: June 1, 2019.

Foundations ESL

Foundations ESL is a rigorous ESL curriculum replacing the language arts block in 6-10th grade. These students need daily help with writing and speaking the English language. Students scoring between 690 - 749 on the TOEFL Jr will be required to be in the Foundations ESL class. Students will receive approximately 120 hours of ESL per year or approximately 3.5 hours of ESL per week.

Pricing

The additional cost for the Foundations ESL program is **\$3,193 per year** paid in full at the time of admission. Due: June 1, 2019.

Full Inclusion ESL

Full Inclusion ESL is a full-time, intensive ESL curriculum designed to develop the basic skills needed to develop proficiency in the listening, speaking, reading, and writing of the English language. Students who are enrolled in the Full Inclusion program will work closely with a highly qualified ESL educator where they will learn functional, social and academic language to strengthen their communication skills. These students will attend ESL full day with the exception of P.E., Art and Study Hall.

ESL Guidelines for Placement: Intermediate and High School Students (based on TOEFL Jr. scores)

TOEFL Jr. Total Score Above 810

- Student has tested out of ESL and will attend regular ELA (English Language Arts) and Spanish class

TOEFL Jr. Total Score of 750 - 810 (Advanced Level)

- Student will attend regular ELA class
- Student will attend ESL instead of Spanish class

TOEFL Jr. Total Score of 690 - 749 (Foundations Level)

- Student will attend ESL during ELA and Spanish class

TOEFL Jr. Total Score Below 690 (Full Inclusion ESL)

- Student will enroll in Full Inclusion ESL for a year of full English instruction with the understanding that they will take a year to study English before enrolling in their current grade level. For example, a student entering 7th grade will take a year of Full Inclusion ESL and enroll in 7th grade the following year.

Elementary Students

The ESL teacher will utilize his/her professional knowledge to determine the correct placement of Elementary students based on admissions testing and/or an interview.
