Summit Christian Academy (SCA) comprises a non-denominational, independent school system, offering grades Pre-K through 12 to the greater Northwest Austin, Texas community. As a college preparatory, coeducational school that began operations in 2003, SCA also features character development rooted in traditional values and a strong emphasis on service to the community. SCA is fully accredited through the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI).

ADMISSION GUIDELINES

Summit Christian Academy offers a program for students who desire an excellent education in a Christ-centered environment. An interview and admission testing is required for all new students. SCA evaluates student candidates based on their character, academic record, and behavioral background. SCA evaluates applicants academically by reviewing a student's most recent report card, his/her academic transcripts, and his/her current scores from a nationally-normed achievement test as well as the student interview. Students scoring in the top 50% of the nationally-normed test are considered for admission.

STUDENT BODY

The total enrollment in 2019-2020 is 222. Elementary (PK-5) enrollment is 105. Middle School (6-8) enrollment is 42, and High School (9-12) enrollment is 75. Sixteen students comprise the Class of 2020.

CLASS RANK

SCA ranks the top two students in each class in order to name Valedictorian and Salutatorian. Except for the top two places, SCA does not rank. SCA uses a graduated 4.0 grading scale. The school offers honors and pre-AP classes on a 5.0 scale, as well as advanced placement and dual credit classes on a 6.0 scale. The Valedictorian and Salutatorian must have attended SCA their last six semesters, and they must maintain the highest two grade point averages (GPA's).

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

All High School students are placed on the Foundations with Multidisciplinary Endorsement. Students may also earn the Distinguished Diploma as well as STEM and Arts& Humanities Endorsements.
