

FAQ's for Re-Enrollment



- What is the deadline for withdrawal?
 - February 21, 2020
- What happens if I withdraw and then want to re-enroll my student after the deadline for re-enrollment?
 - There is a reenrollment fee of \$500.00 upon reenrollment
- What happens if I stay enrolled but my plans change this summer?
 - Your \$500 tuition deposit will not be refunded nor will any tuition payments be refunded that were paid for the 20-21 school year.
- When will the tuition deposit charge my bank account?
 - Ten days after your Facts account for 20-21 has been finalized by our Finance Department (around March 6). Facts will send out an email to you prior to the charge.
- How do I apply for Financial Aid?
 - Financial Aid applications are accepted and processed through Facts Management System, Inc. [Click here](#) and use your username and password.
 - Facts charges a \$35.00 fee.
 - Read [here](#) about the financial aid process.
- When will the Financial Aid be awarded?
 - It will be awarded mid to late Spring.
- When is the deadline to apply for Financial Aid for current families?
 - March 15 is the deadline.
- If I would like to enroll another student, but already have other students at Summit, what do I need to do?
 - Log into Renweb and create a new application.
 - This will start the new student process for your additional student.
- What if I want to change my payment plan?
 - Log in to Facts after March 15. More specific details to come.
- What happens if I apply for Financial Aid and it is not enough for my family and I withdraw my student(s)?
 - The \$500 tuition deposit is non-refundable.
