SNACK SHACK

Expectations—Campers are required to conduct themselves in a manner that honors the Lord. We will be encouraging campers to talk, listen, apologize, and forgive. When necessary, time-out may be used, as well as loss of other privileges. If an issue arises that requires a more serious disciplinary response, parents may be contacted to come pick up their camper for the remainder of the day.

Dress Code—For safety, campers are required to wear athletic shoes. Girls are asked to wear a one-piece swimsuit. If a two piece is worn, a t-shirt must be worn over it. Camp t-shirts will be worn on field trip days.

Health—Parents will be notified immediately to pick up any camper who becomes ill. In order to return to camp after an illness, campers must be fever-free or diarrhea-free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medications or anti-diarrhea medications.
