Symptoms

Do you have a fever greater than 100.0 degrees F?

Do you have any of the following signs/symptoms in a way that is not normal for you:

New uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing (for individuals with chronic allergic/asthmatic cough, a change in their cough from baseline)

Difficulty breathing or Shortness of breath

Chills, Shaking, or exaggerated shivering

Congestion or runny nose

Sore throat

Fatigue

Significant muscle pain or ache not related to injury or exercise

New onset of severe headache, especially with a fever

Diarrhea, vomiting, abdominal pain

New loss of taste or smell

Close Contact

Had close contact (within 6 feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes) with a person with confirmed COVID-19
