



COVID-19 Guidance AY 2023-2024

POSITIVE CASE

In accordance with public health guidelines, students and staff who test positive for COVID-19, regardless of vaccine status, must be excluded from school and extracurricular activities until the following re-entry criteria are met:

- An individual with symptoms:
 - At least 5 days have passed since symptom onset and
 - Fever-free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication. (Fever is a temperature of 100 degrees or higher) and
 - Symptoms are improved
- An individual who tests positive but has no symptoms:
 - At least 5 days have passed since the date they received a positive test result
 - Individuals who have a known exposure to COVID-19 and become symptomatic are considered a presumptive positive and must stay home unless they are able to provide a negative test or alternate diagnosis note from a doctor.
- The date of symptom onset or the positive test result (in the case of someone with no symptoms) is considered day 0. The earliest return day would be day 6 as long as all re-entry criteria are met.

NOTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

- The school nurse must be notified of any student who tests positive for COVID-19. All staff must notify their supervisor.
