

FAQ's for Reenrollment



- What is the deadline to decline enrollment for next year?
 - February 23, 2024
- What happens if I decline continuous enrollment and later decide to reenroll?
 - There is a reenrollment fee of \$800.00 upon reenrollment.
- What happens if I desire to terminate my contract?
 - SCA hires teachers, apportions resources, and limits additional enrollments based on re-enrollment forecasts. You must have tuition insurance to be considered for a release from your contract. To request a contract release, you must meet with the Business Manager. If the Business Manager believes your circumstances are covered under tuition insurance, your case will be forwarded to the Head of School for final determination. If release is granted, all deposits and tuition payments made up to that point are non-refundable.
 - Students withdrawing from February 24, 2024, to December 15, 2024, will be charged half of the annual tuition. Students who withdraw on or after December 16, 2024, will be charged the full annual tuition.
- When will the tuition deposit be charged to my bank account?
 - Ten days after your FACTS account for 24-25 has been finalized by our Finance Department. FACTS will send you an email prior to the charge.
- Is there a multi-student discount?
 - All currently enrolled families receiving a multi-student discount will retain their discount. However, Summit is ending the multi-student discount effective starting the 2024-2025 academic year.
- How do I apply for Financial Aid?
 - Financial Aid applications are accepted and processed through FACTS Management System, Inc. [Click here](#) and use your username and password.
 - FACTS charges a \$35.00 application fee.
 - Current families are prioritized to receive financial aid.

- When is the deadline to apply for Financial Aid for current families?
 - March 20, 2024, is the deadline for current families. Financial aid consideration will open for new families on March 21, 2024.
- When will the Financial Aid be awarded?
 - It will be awarded in late Spring.
- What happens if I apply for Financial Aid and it is not enough for my family, and I withdraw my student(s)?
 - The \$500 tuition deposit is non-refundable.
- If I would like to enroll another student but already have other students at Summit, what do I need to do?
 - Log into FACTS Family Portal, scroll to Apply/Enroll, and follow the prompts to create a new application.
 - This will start the new student process for your additional student.
