

Re-Enrollment FAQs for 2025-2026



- What is the deadline to decline enrollment for next year?
 - February 14, 2025
- What happens if I decline continuous enrollment and later decide to re-enroll?
 - There is a re-enrollment fee of \$800.00 upon re-enrollment.
- What happens if I choose to terminate my contract after the enrollment period?
 - Please be aware that SCA hires teachers, apportions resources, and limits additional enrollments based on re-enrollment forecasts.
 - To request a contract release, you must meet with the Business Manager. If the Business Manager determines your situation meets the release criteria, your case will be reviewed by the Head of School for final approval.
 - If release is granted, all deposits and tuition payments made up to that point are non-refundable.
 - Students withdrawing from February 14, 2025, to December 15, 2025, will be charged half of the annual tuition. Students who withdraw on or after December 16, 2025, will be charged the full annual tuition.
- When will the tuition deposit be charged to my bank account?
 - Ten days after your FACTS account for 2025-2026 has been finalized by our Finance Department. FACTS will send you an email prior to the charge.
- Where can I find the tuition schedule for 2025-2026?
 - Tuition for the 2025-2026 school year is posted on the Summit website.
- Is there a multi-student discount?
 - Summit does not offer a multi-student discount.
- How do I apply for Tuition Assistance?
 - Tuition Assistance applications are accepted and processed through FACTS Management System, Inc. [Click here](#) and use your username and password.
 - FACTS charges a \$45.00 application fee.
 - Current families are prioritized to receive financial aid.

- When is the deadline to apply for Tuition Assistance for current families?
 - March 15, 2025 is the deadline for current families. Tuition Assistance consideration will open for new families on March 16, 2025.
- When will the Tuition Assistance be awarded?
 - It will be awarded in late Spring.
- What happens if I apply for Tuition Assistance and it is not enough for my family, and I withdraw my student(s)?
 - The \$500 tuition deposit is non-refundable.
- If I would like to enroll another student but already have other students at Summit, what do I need to do?
 - Log into FACTS Family Portal, scroll to Apply/Enroll, and follow the prompts to create a new application.
 - This will start the new student process for your additional student.
