CLASS RANK

SCA ranks the **top two students** in each class in order to name Valedictorian and Salutatorian. All other students are not ranked. The Valedictorian and Salutatorian must have attended SCA for six semesters, and they must graduate with the distinguished diploma.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Students complete the **Foundations with Multidisciplinary Endorsement** graduation plan. Students may also earn the **Distinguished Diploma** as well as STEM and Arts & Humanities Endorsements. Distinguished Diploma candidates must complete a summer internship before senior year with a corresponding essay and presentation. All graduates complete **25 service hours per year**. NHS graduates must complete 36 hours per year.

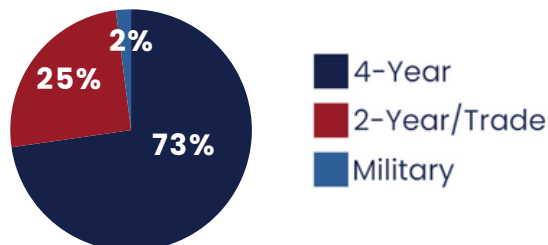


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MATRICULATION DATA (2022-2025)

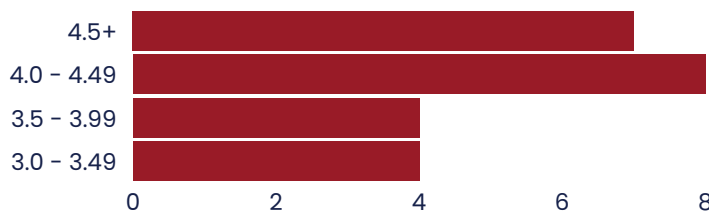
SCA partners with Austin Community College, Colorado Christian University, and LeTourneau University for Dual Credit courses.
