✓ Learn How To Drop-Off & Pick-Up

The [Drop-Off & Pick-Up Map](#) shows where each grade should be let out of the car and picked up each day. Drivers of elementary students need to display the car tag provided at the Back to School Event on the left side of their car windshield when picking up. If younger students need help strapping in at pick up, please pull forward (out of the carpool line) before getting out to assist your child.

Only PreK and Kindergarten students may be walked to classrooms the first day of school. Teachers will take "first day of school" pictures for all others.

[Login to FACTS](#) (Summit's enrollment management system) to ensure your student's information is correct by selecting Web Forms under the School heading. Next, select the Family Demographic Form and verify the following are up-to-date:

The entree menu is updated monthly. Breakfast is available weekdays 7:30 - 7:55 am and does not require a pre-order.
